THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY WAS FOUNDED IN NOVEMBER 1988 . IT RUNS TWO ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES ON ITS OWN , NAMELY MA AND PHD. THE DEPARTMENT AT PRESENT HAS A SEAT CAPACITY OF 56 STUDENTS IN ITS MA COURSE. THE DEPARTMENT HAS SIX FACULTY MEMBERS . 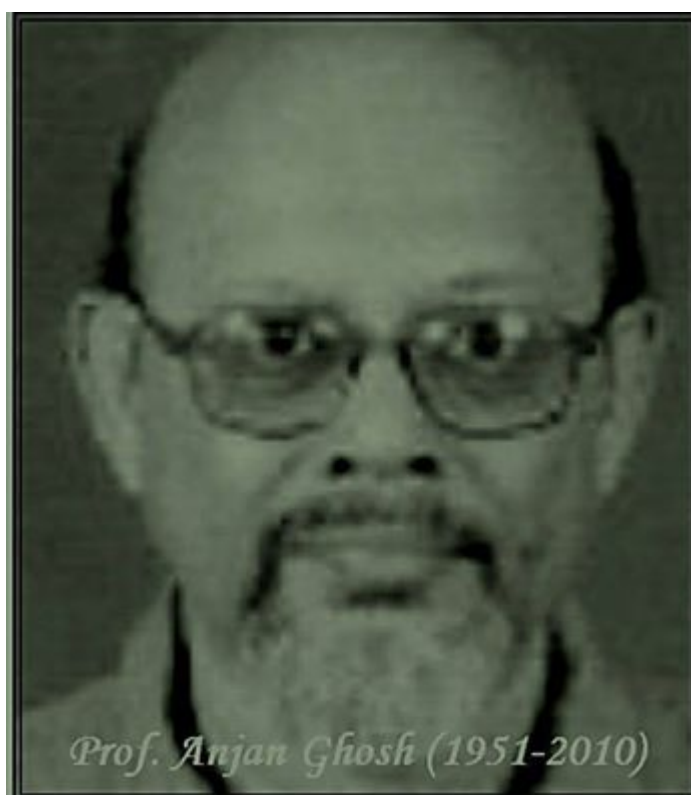
