The University of Burdwan is going to organize Five days Summer Science Camp on INSPIRE Internship during **October 03 to 07, 2018** for the talented students of top 1% performance in Class X - Board Examination and pursuing **Science** at plus 2 levels, *i.e.*, XI & XII. Selection will be done by the Coordinator, INSPIRE INTERNSHIP - 2018. Selection procedure will be on the basis of top rankers in the examination.
