**Modalities of final Year/Semester Examinations 2019-20 at  
UG and PG level**

Resolution of the Online Executive Council meeting of the University of Burdwan held on July 17, 2020 at 12:00 noon.

The following guidelines have been approved for the finalization of results of different UG/PG Courses/Programmes for the Academic Session 2019-2020 which were due or incomplete during the Lock Down Period.

**Under Graduate B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. – Semester VI (under CBCS) / Part – III (Old), 1+1+1  
pattern**

- 1) 80% weightage be put on the best performance in the previous five semesters (i.e. Semester – I, II, III, IV & V) and this be derived from previous five best aggregate percentage/SGPA. 20% weightage be put on Internal Assessment (IA) where these marks are to be derived from the best performance in IA of Semesters I to V.
- 2) For the final year students (Old Part-III) with no provision of Internal Assessment, 100% weightage be put on the better performance in the previous two Parts' Examinations (i.e., Old Part-I & Part-II). Regarding the back papers of Part-III, marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-III Examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier. Regarding the back papers of Part-II, marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-II Examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier.
- 3) Students of Intermediate Semesters (Semester-II & Semester-IV) be allowed to continue uninterruptedly in the next Semester.

**Regarding finalization of the results of different practical examinations/field and track work/  
project assignment of UG (CBCS) Semester-III & Semester-V which could not be taken owing  
to Lock Down situation**

- i) For Semester –V Honours examinees, highest marks of practical component in the previous four Semesters (to be calculated Semester wise on the basis of total of practical marks in the semester divided by number of practical based courses) be considered as practical marks of the subject in the 5<sup>th</sup> Semester (Core Courses and DSEs)
- ii) Accordingly, for General Course examinees, highest marks of the subject in the previous four Semesters be treated as Practical marks of DSE Course of the subject in the 5<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- iii) For other courses without any Practical component in the previous four Semesters, proportionate marks of Theoretical Course and Internal Assessment taken together be treated as mark of the Practical component of the subject.
- iv) For Practical/Field Work/Project paper submission based SEC Courses (such as Geography, Physical Education), proportionate Marks of Internal Assessment (10 marks) be treated marks of the Practical component (40).



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v) It is also resolved that the above logic be followed in awarding marks on the Practical component of any subject in which the practical examinations cannot be held due to college closure in the event of outbreak of COVID-19.

**Post Graduate**

**M.A./M.Sc./M.Com./M.Lib.I.Sc./MCSA/LLM/M.B.A./M.B.A.(HR)/M.B.A.(T)/M.PEd./M.Ed**  
**– Semester IV (under CBCS)**

- 1) Computation of results and relevant tabulation sheets of Semester-IV Examinations (Final), 2020 will be prepared as under:-
  - a) 80% weightage be considered on the basis of the best aggregate percentage as obtained by the candidate concerned in any of the previous three Semesters' (i.e. Semester-I, Semester-II & Semester-III) results and paper/course wise marks in Semester-IV Examinations, 2020 will be calculated and finalized accordingly.
  - b) Remaining 20% marks will be awarded by the respective teachers (examiners) of the Department concerned as marks of 'internal assessment' of current Semester (i.e. Semester-IV).
- 2) The above noted modalities will be applicable only for the successful candidates in their relevant Semester-I, Semester-II & Semester-III Examinations. However, the marks of internal assessment for those examinees will be retained.
- 3) In case of back candidate(s) of previous Semester-IV Examination, the average marks scored in the paper(s)/course(s) appeared at their last Semester-IV Examination in which the candidate qualified will be treated as final marks in their relevant back paper(s)/course(s) and their results of Semester-IV Examinations, 2020 will be finalized accordingly, if chance remains.
- 4) Students of Intermediate Semester (Semester-II) be allowed to continue uninterruptedly in the next Semester.
- 5) For Semester-VI of 3 year LL.B.(H), the papers that could not be taken due to Covid – 19 Pandemic, the marks of these paper be awarded from the best performance of the other papers in the concerned Semester.

**Under Graduate B.Ed.– Semester IV**

1. Computation of results and relevant tabulation sheets of Semester-IV Examination (Final), 2020 will be prepared as under:-
  - a) 80% weightage be considered on the basis of the best aggregate percentage as obtained by the candidate concerned in any of the previous three Semesters' (i.e. Semester-I, Semester-II & Semester-III) results in theory and practical separately and paper/course wise marks in Semester-IV Examinations, 2020 will be calculated and finalized accordingly.
  - b) Remaining 20% marks will be awarded by the respective college concerned as marks of 'internal assessment' of current Semester (i.e. Semester-IV).
2. The above noted modalities will be applicable only for the successful candidates in their relevant Semester-I, Semester-II & Semester-III Examinations. However, the marks of internal assessment for those examinees will be retained.



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3. In case of back candidate(s) of previous Semester-IV Examination, the average marks scored in the paper(s)/course(s) appeared at their last Semester-IV Examination in which the candidate qualified will be treated as final marks in their relevant back paper(s)/course(s) and their results of Semester-IV Examinations, 2020 will be finalized accordingly, if chance remains.
4. Students of Intermediate Semester(s) be allowed to continue uninterruptedly in the next Semester.

**Under Graduate Professional BBA, BCA – Part III**

1. Computation of results and relevant tabulation sheets of Part III Examination (Final), 2020 will be prepared as under:-
  - a) 80% weightage be considered on the basis of the best aggregate percentage as obtained by the candidate concerned in any of the previous two Parts (i.e. Part-I & Part-II) results and paper/course wise marks in Part III Examination, 2020 will be calculated and finalized accordingly.
  - b) Remaining 20% marks will be awarded by the respective college concerned from the assignment based-evaluation.
2. In case of back candidate(s) of previous Part III marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-III examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier, if chance remains. In case of back candidate(s) of previous Part II marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-II examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier, if chance remains. In case of back candidate(s) of previous Part I marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-I examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier, if chance remains.
3. Students of Intermediate Semester(s) be allowed to continue uninterruptedly in the next Semester.

**Under Graduate Professional BioTechnology, BioChemistry– Semester VI /  
Part – III (Old), 1+1+1 pattern**

1. 80% weightage be put on the best performance in the previous five semesters (i.e. Semester – I, II, III, IV & V) and this be derived from previous five best aggregate percentage. 20% weightage be put on Internal Assessment (IA) and that be derived from the best performance in IA from Semester-I to Semester-V.
2. For the final year students (Old Part-III) having no Internal Assessment, 100% weightage be put on the better performance in the previous two part's examinations (i.e. Old Part-I & Part-II). Regarding the back papers of Part-III marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-III examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier. Regarding the back papers of Part-II marks will be awarded on the basis of the average marks obtained in the remaining papers of Old Part-II examinations in which the candidate qualified earlier.
3. Students of Intermediate Semester(s) be allowed to continue uninterruptedly in the next Semester.



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**General Guidelines**

- 1) *Appearance as repeat/improvement end semester/part examinations does not arise as the University is not in a position to conduct the said examination due to COVID-19 pandemic situation. However, if a student wishes to appear in a formal examination instead of alternate evaluation method, as stated above, he/she will be given an opportunity to apply for the same within one month of publication result by surrendering the said marksheet/gradecard. However, the said examination will be conducted only after the situation gets normalized and the result of the said special examination will be published within one month of the examination being held. The final result marks will be revised as per the student's performance in the special examination, irrespective of whether he/she secures more or less marks than what is awarded to him/her through alternate evaluation method. To this effect, an undertaking will be obtained from the student before allowing him/her to appear in the special examination.*
- 2) *In absence of the relevant answer-scripts, provision of Post-publication Review system and scrutiny will not be applicable, and naturally, the question of supplying photocopy of answer-scripts and inspection of the same under RTI Act. 2005 will not arise.*
- 3) *Examination Fees relating to the final year/semester/part Examinations will be waived due to COVID-19 pandemic for this year as a very special case.*
