Online Applications in prescribed form are invited for admission to two-year full time M. Tech in Electronics and Communication Engineering (Microwaves) Course for the session 2019-2021 at the Department of Physics against the vacant seats after first round of admission. The course is approved by AICTE.

Eligibility: B.E. or B. Tech. Electronics/ Electronics and Telecommunication Engg./ Electronics and Communication Engg./ Radio Physics/ Electronics/ M.Sc. in Electronics/ M.Sc. in Physics with Advanced Papers in Electronics with at least 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent. Candidates awaiting their final result may also apply provisionally subject to production of Final Result before the commencement of the Interview. GATE- qualified candidates in EC/ IN will get preference. A few seats are kept reserved for sponsored candidates fulfilling the basic eligibility and having at least two-year full-time work experience in a Registered Firm/Industry/R&D Institution etc after acquiring the basic eligibility criteria. Non – GATE candidates may also be considered for admission, if seats are not filled up by the GATE qualified and/or sponsored candidates. Forms will be filled up in the University Website <http://www.buruniv.ac.in> from 11.09.2019 to 16.09.2019 on payment of Rs. 450/-. Reservation for S.C./ S.T. and Disabled candidates will be as per rules. Scholarship for GATE qualified candidates is subject to availability of fund from AICTE through DBT mode. Candidates awaiting results of final qualifying examination may be considered for admission subject to their submission of such results on or before the date of test/interview.

INFORMATION SHEET (Re-Advertisement)

1. **Eligibility:** B.E. or B. Tech. Electronics/ Electronics and Telecommunication Engg./ Electronics and Communication Engg./ Radio Physics/ Electronics/ M.Sc. in Electronics/ M.Sc. in Physics with Advanced Papers in Electronics with at least 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent. Candidates awaiting their final result may also apply provisionally subject to production of Final Result before the commencement of the Interview.
2. Online Applications are to be completed using the link provided in University Website <http://www.buruniv.ac.in> on or before **16th September, 2019**. Forms may be filled up during the period from **11.09.2019 to 16.09.2019 (both dates inclusive)**.
3. The applicants would be classified in three categories viz. Category A: GATE-qualified in EC/ IN, Category B: Sponsored Candidates having at least 2 years' working experience in related field after passing out and Category C: Non-GATE candidates.
4. Candidates falling under category C will be considered for admission **only if** seats remain vacant after admission of candidates under Categories A& B. A written test of one hour duration will be held to prepare a short list of candidates falling under category C.
5. **Selection criteria:** Merit of selection of the candidates under different categories would be determined on the basis of the following: **For Category-A:** GATE Score (70%), marks in B.E./ B.Tech/M.Sc (10%) and performance in the interview (20%); For **Category-B (Sponsored):** Performance in the interview and work experience; **For Category-C:** Marks of written test(70%), marks in B.E./ B.Tech/M.Sc (10%) and performance in the interview (20%).
6. List of selected/ short listed candidates, as applicable, will be displayed in the university website (www.buruniv.ac.in).
7. Candidates will be required to produce copy of E-Receipt, printout of Application Form, the original copies of their testimonials at the time of written test, interview and also at the time of admission, if selected. Sponsored candidates must submit necessary release order from the appropriate authorities.
8. The copy of E-Receipt, printout of Application Form will be treated as the Provisional Admit Card without which the applicants may not be allowed to sit for the admission test/appear at the interview.
9. Candidates admitted to the course shall not be permitted to prosecute any other course of studies or be engaged any job (part-time or full-time) or to prosecute alongside any full-time research work during the tenure of the course.
10. The form filling procedure is exclusively in Online Mode. The online application fee for the courses is Rs.450/-.

11. After the completion of form filling, interviews will be held as per following schedule :

13. Classes for the course has already commenced on August 22, 2019.

14. For GATE-qualified candidates, unique student ID would be created in the AICTE portal within 15 working days of commencement of classes (subject to technical feasibility) for availing GATE scholarship from AICTE. For the purpose, the students MUST have to fulfill the necessary requirements prescribed by the Department. On obtaining the Unique student's ID, a student has to give at list 15 working days' advance notice to cancel his/ her studentship from the course.

15. As per requirements of AICTE, all students admitted to the course and their parents/ guardians MUST submit anti-ragging affidavits in the prescribed format in Non Judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/-. Prescribed formats would be supplied at the time of admission. As per directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, it is notified that in any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution.

16. As per requirement of the course, the students have to peruse one year project work/ internship during the second year (Semester III & IV) of study at anywhere in India including The University of Burdwan as per the decision of the Department. In this regard, all students admitted to the course must submit a declaration counter signed by their parents/ guardians in a specified format at the time of the admission. The format would be provided at the time of viva-voce examination.
