

FAQs

1. Are all first and second rank holders at undergraduate level eligible for applying under the scheme?

The First and Second Rank holders at undergraduate level and who are admitted in any Postgraduate Course would be awarded the scholarship in application . The students will have to submit the proof of their merit position at undergraduate level as well as their admission in postgraduate courses.

2. Is there a minimum percentage of marks for applying under the scheme?

Yes. The candidates applying under the scheme should have secured at least 60% of marks at undergraduate level to be eligible to apply under the scheme.

3. Are only students enrolled in Universities eligible to apply under the scheme?

The first and second rank holders (Not position holders) would be considered from Universities/ Institutions and non-affiliated/ autonomous colleges according to the number of students who have appeared in the examination at undergraduate level as per following table.

Nature of Institution	Number of students who appeared in examination at undergraduate level
Affiliating Universities (State/ Central)	100
Deemed Universities/ Private Universities / Autonomous Colleges / Non-affiliated colleges	25

4. Are candidates holding positions in Universities at undergraduate level eligible to apply under the scheme?

No. Only those candidates who are first or second rank holders in the university are eligible to apply.

5. Can a candidate pursuing post graduation through distance mode apply under the scheme?

No.

6. Are awardees entitled for hostel fee reimbursement, contingency, HRA or medical expenses?

No. Contingency, HRA, hostel fee reimbursement or medical expenses are not admissible under the scheme.

7. Can the awardee avail of any other scholarship scheme during the tenure of this award?

Yes.

FAQs

1. Whether a girl child with a brother in the family is eligible to be considered under the scheme for award of scholarship.
No, only single girl child are eligible to apply under the scheme. However twin/ fraternal daughters are eligible to apply under this scheme.
2. Whether a candidate who was within 30 years of age during admission to PG course but has crossed this limit at the time of application be eligible to be considered.
Yes. The candidate applying under the scheme can apply if she is below 30 years of age as on the last date of application too.
3. Can a single girl child pursuing post graduation through distance mode apply under the scheme?
No.
4. After selection, is the awardee entitled for hostel fee reimbursement/ HRA or medical expenses?
No. The awardee is only entitled for scholarship amount. No HRA/contingency/hostel fee or medical expenses are admissible.
5. Are the awardees eligible for waiver of tuition fee or its reimbursement?
No. Tuition fee reimbursement is not permitted. However, it is expected from the institutions where student has taken admission in the first year PG course, no tuition fees will be charged by the institute from girl students to pursue PG degree course in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
6. Can students of second year post graduation apply under the scheme?
No. The candidates who are pursuing first year postgraduate courses only can apply under the scheme.
7. Can the awardee avail of any other scholarship scheme during the tenure of this award?
Yes. This scheme can be availed with any other scholarship scheme as this is an incentive.
