About the University

About the Department

The department of Biotechnology in the University of Burdwan was initiated in 2003 in conjunction with the generous support of an NRI, Dr. Asish K. Mondal who donated two endowment chairs: for a professor and a SRF. In 2006, the department was recognized by DBT, Govt. of INDIA. The Department has excelled in its master's program. Most of the ex-students are pursuing their research career either abroad or in different National level Institutes of the country. While the above is satisfactory, a great deal of work is to be done for further improvements.

Abstract

Abstracts and full papers are to be prepared and submitted (both soft and a hard copies) following the instructions given below. Specify the sub-theme and mention it on the top of the Abstract.

Content : The Abstract should indicate the original research work undertaken and the scale of new thinking, technology or methods. Papers with special emphasis on case studies are particularly invited.

Abstracts and full papers should be written in English within 500 words and must be prepared using PC-based MS Word software. Use 12 point, Times Roman font, 1.5 lines space, and leave 1" (2.5 cm) margins on all sides. Leave one

blank line between paragraphs, but no indent paragraph.

Title : Title of the abstract should be furnished with the Author's name and address including e-mail ID. The underlined author is expected to make presentation at the conference. List of co-authors should also be mentioned with full names and addresses if different. Delegates are required to make their presentation within the time limit of fifteen minutes to be followed by interaction for five minutes.

Review : All abstracts will be reviewed. The Scientific / Technical Program Committee will decide on the selection of the abstracts for presentation and publication in the Abstract Volume.

Notification of Acceptance

1. Last date of submission of the Abstract and full paper by e-mail and hard copy - 18-02-2010
2. Last date of the Committee's decision on acceptance of the Abstract - 28-02-2010 (author may contact through e-mail / phone for information of acceptance of the Abstract after this date).
3. Requisition for accommodation latest by 05-03-2010.
4. Last date of Registration February, 18th, 2010.
