The Department was established with a PG Diploma Course in 1997 under the Faculty Council of Arts. The Diploma course was discontinued in the year 2000 and two-year Master Degree course in Mass Communication had been introduced. Presently, the University offers UG BA (Honours and Genera) Courses under CBSC system in Mass Communication and Journalism, UG CCFUP under new NEP 2020, M.A. and Ph.D. programme in Mass Communication.
