- The colleges will not deduct any amount from the examination fee, enrolment fee and practical examination fee (for the examinees of Honours categories). The amount thus collected shall have to submit to the University along with the examination forms within the date as per notification to be issued by the Controller of Examinations.
- The amount of "centre subsidy" received by the Centre of Examinations for conducting Honours Practical Examinations be utilized towards cost of materials, refreshment and remunerations to the examiners and other personnel involved in the Practical Examinations.

Only T.A./D.A. to the examiners will be paid by the University. **Necessary claim towards payment of "centre subsidy" and requisition of advance for spot payment of T.A./D.A. to the examiners may be made by the Centre of Examinations in the prescribed forms available from "Bill & Spot Payment Section" of the Department of Controller of Examinations much ahead of the commencement of Honours Practical Examinations.**

Teachers who will act as examiners in Honours Practical Examination in their own college centre for the candidates of other colleges are entitled to get Daily Allowance @Rs.40/- for each examination day including preparation day.

- Practical examination fees for General/Pass/Major Subjects/Papers thus collected are to be retained by the colleges for conducting practical examinations of their students and to meet up the expenses towards payment of T.A./D.A. as per University rules to the external examiners (if any), refreshment etc. Daily Allowance to the External Examiners will be paid on and from the date of commencement of the examination. The University will not reimburse any amount on account of T.A./D.A., refreshment etc.

However, the amount required for payment of remuneration (as per prescribed rate) for assessing answer scripts of practical examinations will be given by the University. The amount required for such payment be deducted at source, i.e., from the examination fees.

- For non-traditional General course subjects (such as Physical Education, Defence Studies etc.) and for professional courses such as Engineering, B.H.M.S., B.B.A., B.C.A., Bio-technology, Bio-chemistry, B.V.A., B.P.T., Condensed B.P.T. etc. :-

- (1) The affiliated college would bear all expenditure towards conduct of Practical Examinations of the subjects. No centre subsidy, T.A./D.A. etc. will be paid by the University.
- (2) The amount required for payment of remuneration for assessing answer scripts of practical examinations will be paid by the University. However, the amount required for such payment be deducted at source, i.e., from the examination fees collected from the examinees.
- (3) Centre subsidy at the prescribed rate(s) collected by the colleges from the examinees of their own will have to be submitted to the centre of examinations directly by the colleges before the commencement of the practical examinations.

(d) Number of students to be examined (for practical examination): -

For all Honours subjects (except Physics) :	Minimum 16 (sixteen) candidates per day per paper
For Physics Honours	: Minimum 10 (ten) candidates per day per paper
For all General subjects	: Minimum 16 (sixteen) candidates per day per paper

(e) Looking over of answer scripts of practical examinations (Honours/General): -

32 (thirty two) scripts per day. Haltage to the external examiners will be paid accordingly, i.e., one day haltage per 32 scripts of Full Paper.

Scripts will have to be assessed at the Centre of Examinations within the specified period of haltage. After submission of marks T.A./D.A./Remunerations etc. (at the rates prescribed by the University) will be paid by the Centre of Examinations on spot. The Officer-in-Charge/Principal will take necessary steps for immediate submission of marks to the Convener/Chairpersons concerned.

- (f) **Sample preparation fees** (for Chemistry practical examination) including cost of chemicals etc.:-
Rs. 15/- per candidate for General Chemistry Practical and be paid by the University to the Convener.
- A candidate who fails to pass/qualify or to present himself/herself at an examination or does not fulfil the requirements for appearing at the examination shall not be entitled to claim refund of any type of fees.
