ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY OF BURDWAN

Burdwan University started on 15th June, 1960, with Sukumar Sen, an ICS, as its first Vice-Chancellor. It was after the abolition of the Zamindari system in the fifties that Uday Chand Mahtab, the last representative of the Burdwan Raj, showed his magnanimity in leaving almost his entire property of Burdwan at the disposal of the state government. This, coupled with the initiative of the then Chief Minister of West Bengal, Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy, facilitated the establishment of this university. Presently, the administrative works are mostly done at Rajbati (the palace of Barddhamana Maharaja) campus; on the other hand, academic activities center around the Golapbag campus mainly.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

The journey of the Department of Education dates back to December 1976. The department imparts two parallel streams of Post Graduate courses viz. M.A. in Education and M.Ed. The Department also offers B.Ed. Programme as well as Ph.D. in Education. The Department was erstwhile known as Institute of Science Education and transformed into the Department of Education in the year 2010. And ever since,

the department is running with excellence and looking forward to the brightest future.

LOCATION AND CLIMATE

Geographically Barddhaman (erstwhile Burdwan) is 23.16° North and 87.54° East with a mean altitude of 30 meters, about 100 kilometers northwest of Kolkata. The nearest airport is Netaji Subhash International Airport at Dumdum, Kolkata which is about one and a half hours drive through Durgapur Express Highway (NH2). Bardhaman is well connected through rails and roads to almost all the parts of the country. Nearest Railway Station is Barddhaman which is about 2 kilometers away from the university. Average temperature of the city during summer is 35° to 40° C & during winter is 18° to 22° C.
